ESL (18 hours per week)



English as a Second Language (ESL) is our most popular Intensive English Program. It combines 3 classes:

Listening & Speaking: Focuses on the conversation, pronunciation, and listening skills.

Reading & Vocabulary: Focuses on essential reading skills, line scanning, skimming, and comprehension.

Grammar & Writing: Focuses on grammar for spoken English at the beginning and intermediate levels and academic writing in the upper intermediate and advanced levels.



Vacation Program (13.5-15.5 hours per week)



The **Vacation English** program provides students with the opportunity to explore in and around the Los Angeles area while helping improve confidence in using English in everyday situations.

Based on LSI popular intensive ESL program, the Vacation English Program focuses on listening, speaking, grammar and reading skills, but it has less rigorous academic requirements, helping students improve while having enough time to explore California.



Business English (18 hours per week)



The **Business English Program** is offered at the intermediate and advanced levels and consists of three classes: Business Communications, Business Theory and Meetings, and Business Practice. This course will expose students to the language and culture of the business world, particularly in North America.

TOEFL® (18 hours per week)



The intensive TOEFL iBT® class prepares students for the iBT by presenting and practicing strategies to help them improve their reading, vocabulary, listening, speaking and writing skills. In addition, students are given practice in critical thinking and note-taking skills.

This class is beneficial for who need a TOEFL® score to get into a university or graduate school program and students who need a TOEFL® score to enter a profession in the US (such as nursing or pharmacy).









Mutual Recognition Program (MRP)

LSI has special agreement, known as "Mutual Recognition Program" (MRP), with several universities in Los Angeles. These partnerships allow students to be accepted into these institutions without the need of taking the TOEFL® exam.


